

## The Female Gaze

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Increasingly, female photographers have been reclaiming representations of women. At Artsy, we worked with Amanda de Cadenet's company Girlgaze (which supports female photographers and directors) to source Lina Plioplyte for a just-launched film series with Gucci, and on my desk, I always keep a copy of Charlotte Jansen's book *Girl on Girl*, which spotlights 40 young female photographers.

I've also consistently stopped on Instagram at the sensitive, truthful depictions of women in an ongoing project, "Girls," by Ronan McKenzie, a young British photographer best known for her series diversifying perceptions of the black body.

It's all part of a wider trend that has spread across culture: photographers challenging and evolving cultural stereotypes. **Rf**

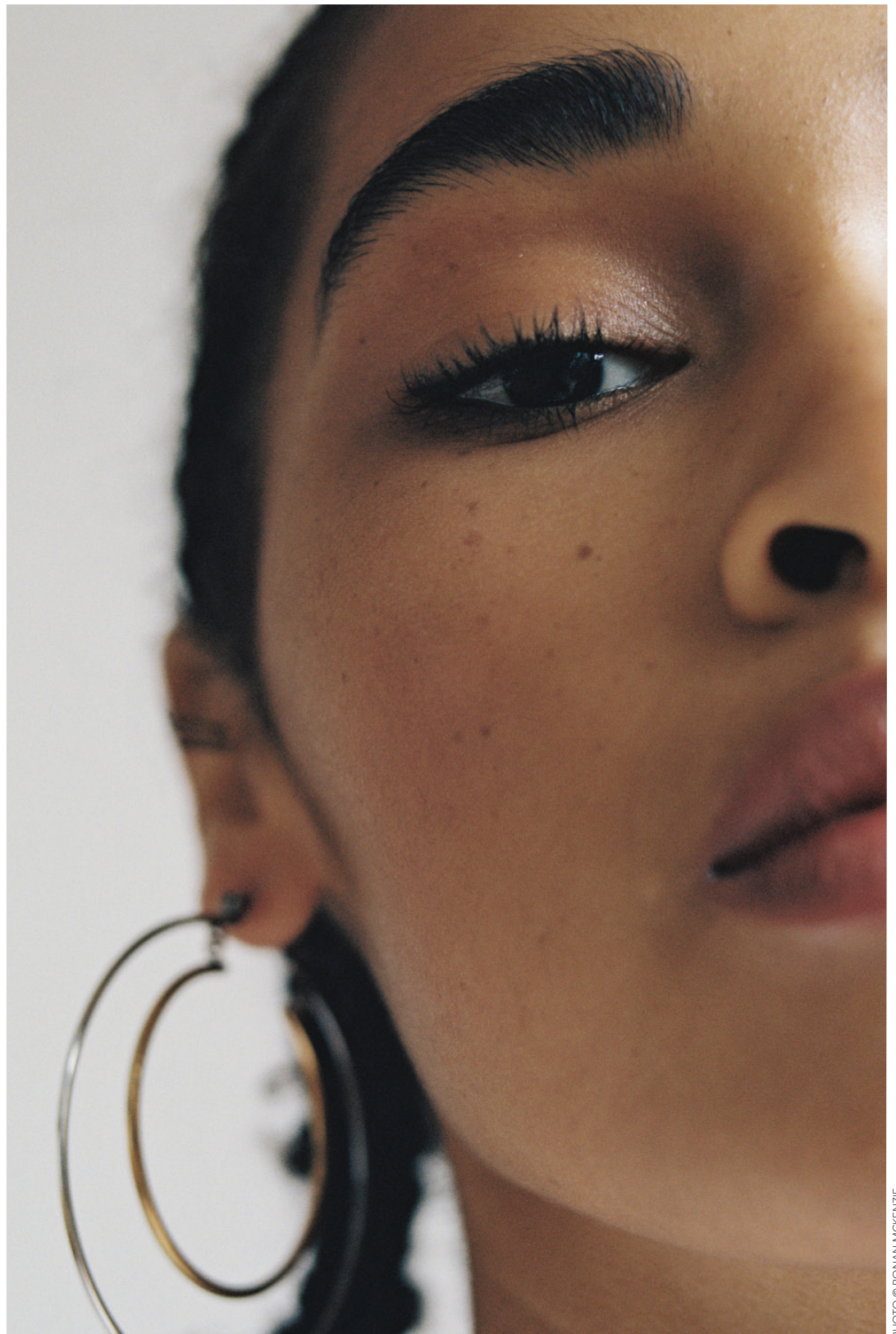


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
